## **Brigadoon Takes Best Special Effects Float at Chasco**

The West Pasco Chamber of Commerce organizes Chasco Fiesta, in part to benefit more than thirty community groups. The Holiday Rotary stages the street parade.

Ye Enchanted Krewe of Brigadoon took home the Best Special Effects Award.



In addition, the following awards were presented: The Krewe of Chasco and the City of New Port Richey won top honors at the Chasco Fiesta street parade. The krewe's float featuring members in American Indian garb, tepees and other Indian symbols was named best in the professional float category.

The best use of color honors in the professional category went to the float entered by the Morton Plant Trinity Outpatient Center and Morton Plant North Bay Hospital.

Ye Enchanted Krewe of Brigadoon took home the Best Special Effects Award.

Judges named Krewe of the Caribbean Cowboys the best out-of-town entry.

The Gaucho Association of Tampa claimed honors for most entertaining float.

In the nonprofessional category, the City of New Port Richey's float was deemed most outstanding.

Sunray Elementary School and Yost Construction put together a float with the best use of color.

Clown Towners Alley 242 earned the award for most entertaining.

## **God's Pedal Power Ministry Event**

In conjunction with their Bar Roll Social on Thursday, January 13th, Ye Enchanted Krewe of Brigadoon supported God's Pedal Power Ministry (GPPM) through bike rentals and charitable contributions.

To get in shape for parade season, Ye Enchanted Krewe of Brigadoon organized a Roll rather than a Stroll and encouraged all attendees to bring their roller blades, roller skates, and bicycles.

GPPM is located on the grounds of the University Baptist Church at the corners of 22nd and 131st streets in St. Petersburg. They fall under the insurance wing and the 501(C)3 classification of this church. They are 100% volunteers. No one affiliated with the bike ministry makes money. GPPM receives used bicycles and refurbishes them and gives them away to needy children and adults at no charge along with a safety lesson and a helmet.

## Membership Updates for April 1<sup>st</sup> 2005 through March 31<sup>st</sup> 2006

In March 2005, the Board ratified and the Full Membership voted to pass important changes to our membership stipulations. Our Membership Committee did an awesome job. Please thank these people when you see them since they have some more work ahead of them for the upcoming year: Paula Proch - Chair, Barbara White,



Bob Schmidt, Louie Dalton, and Shelly Bugman. We look forward to a great year and please recruit more of your great friends to join our awesome organization!!

1. **The Krewe's Membership Cap: 150** members.
2. **New Member Recruiting Season:** April 1st to August 31st. Membership closes Aug 31<sup>st</sup>.
3. **Membership Dues: \$125** Due in full by COB July 1<sup>st</sup>.
4. **Initiation fee: \$150** required at the time of application for new members. Checks will ONLY be deposited when the candidate is notified of acceptance for membership. This fee includes the initiation and application fee. The new member would also have membership dues of \$125 to be paid in full by July 1st if application accepted prior to this date. If accepted after July 1st, membership dues would be paid in full at the time membership notification is made.
5. **Parade Participation Requirements:** Remain unchanged, 4 meetings and 4 charity events per parade season. Requirements accounting start on April 1st and should be completed by January for the start of the Gasparilla parade season.
6. **New members:** Are integrated into the Krewe during the recruitment period of April 1st through Aug 31st. If the membership cap of 150 is not met by August 31st, then membership will close and roll over to the next Krewe season of April 1st.
7. **Open Membership Slot:** Is filled during the Krewe recruitment cycle of April 1st to August 31st if a member quits, is expelled, or does not pay dues in full by July 1st.
8. **Waiting List:** Is being maintained by the membership committee and prospective members contacted when a slot opens. Application Fee/Initiation Fee/Dues are due according to the schedule above. See contact info on our website.
9. **Applications:** Are on our website and are to be mailed with a check made out to Krewe of Brigadoon to our krewe address.
